**Re: Problem Citation Abated, Disturbance to Hydrologic Balance, Home Office Mine,  
Permit No. M-1977-439**

Ms. Mikulas:

On August 17, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) cited a problem for failure to minimize disturbances to the prevailing hydrologic balance of the affected land and of the surrounding area both during and after the mining operation and during reclamation at the Home Office Mine, Permit File No. M-1977-439. On November 3, 2023 the Division received an email showing the groundwater level in HO-1 had fallen below 4 feet below ground surface after the modified north underdrain had been installed. Along with the groundwater level data submission was the as-built construction drawings of the north underdrain. Therefore the Division has abated the problem cited in the August 17, 2023 letter.
