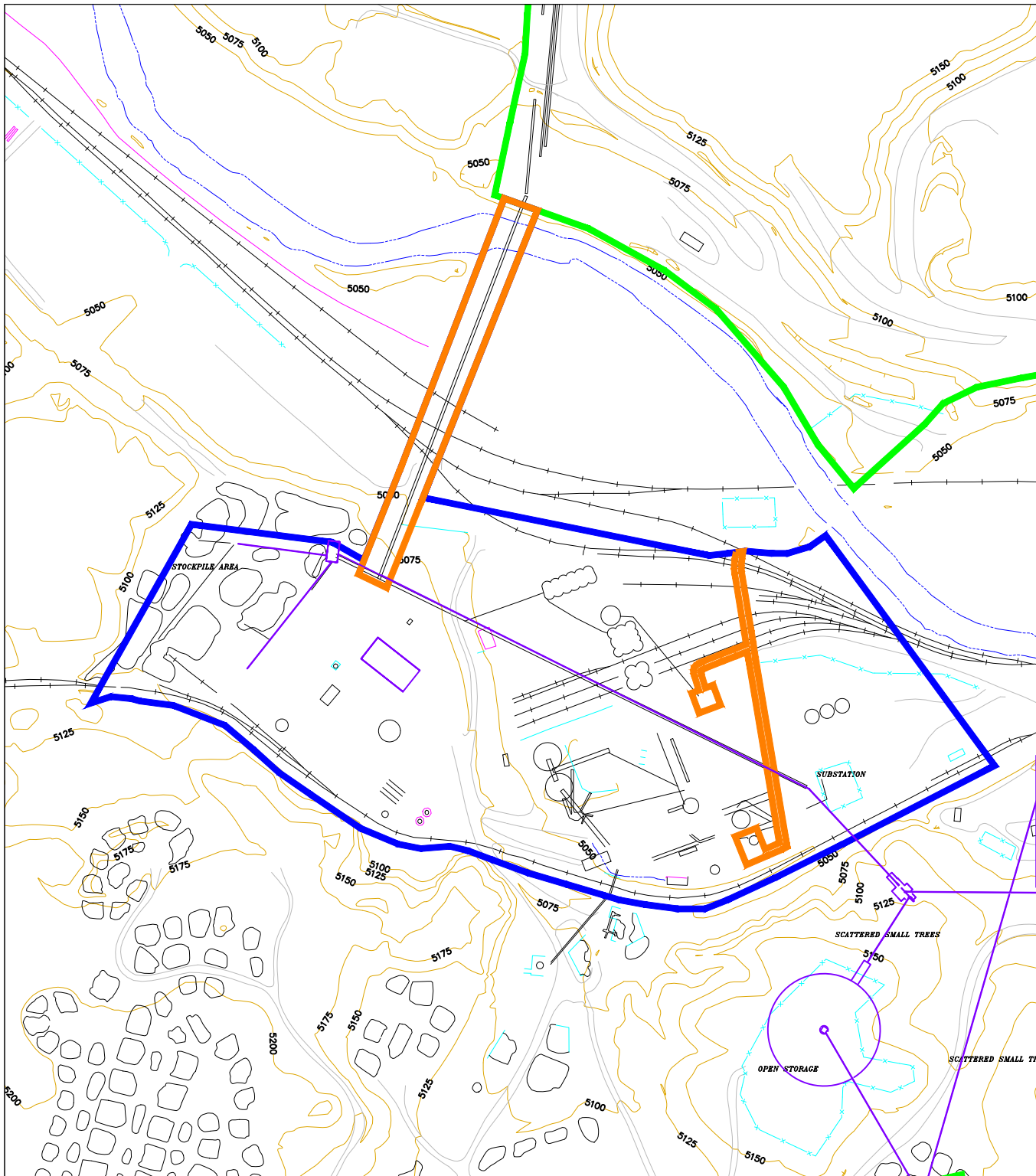

Thanks for the report. Attached please find the changes/modifications to the Acreage Reduction as well as an updated Acreage Reduction Form that reflects the changes. The areas are defined as follows:

1. Total Plant Area - 65.27 Acres (Blue)

3. Acreage to be Released - 60.74 Acres
