Dear Mr. Wein:

Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association Inc. (Tri-State), is the parent company to Elk Ridge Mining and Reclamation, LCC (ERMR), New Horizon Mine. Therefore, Tri-State on behalf of ERMR is submitting minor revision 127 (MR-127) to Permit No. C-1981-008.

MR-127 proposes to revise the location of surface water monitoring site SW-N1 to the west of its current location. The property that SW-N1 is currently on is being sold to a private entity and ERMR will no longer have access to the location. Therefore, MR-127 proposes a location that ERMR can access for continued surface water sampling at an upgradient location on Tuttle Draw.
