Dear Mr. Roberts,

In accordance with Rule 3. 03. 2(2) of the Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Coal Mining, the Division is required to conduct a bond release inspection within 30 days of finding the SL25 bond release application complete or as soon after, as the Division determines that weather conditions allow.

Based on the current ground conditions of the bond release areas and mine site access, the Division will schedule the bond release inspection in the late spring or early summer of 2024. Specific scheduling of the SL25 bond release inspection date will be determined based on weather and ground conditions at the site.
