I was forwarded your question regarding the GCC Rio Grande Inc discharge certification C0G501540. The general permit expired on December 31, 2021. This facility submitted a renewal permit application, so the certification has been administratively continued until the renewal permit is effective. The division has not yet started working on the renewal permit. I have attached a copy of the administrative extension letter that we sent to the facility in September 2021. Since they have administrative extension, the permittee is still authorized to discharge from the outfall location in the certification and the terms and conditions of the certification still apply. The Water Quality Control Division received an application from GCC Rio Grande Inc renewal on 6/23/2021. The application requests discharge authorization for GCC Rio Grande Pueblo located at 3372 Lime Rd Pueblo Facility SIC 3241.

The application has been reviewed and is considered complete for the purposes of filing. The Division has not verified all of the information contained in your application and has relied upon your signed certification to determine that the information is true, accurate, and complete. No renewal permit has been issued at this time.

In the event that the Division does not issue a renewal permit in advance of the permit expiration date of 12/31/2021, the expired permit shall be administratively extended and continue in force to the effective date of the new permit. **THIS IS OFFICIAL NOTICE OF YOUR ELIGIBILITY OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXTENSION AND THE PERMIT SHALL BECOME ADMINISTRATIVELY EXTENDED ON THE DATE FOLLOWING YOUR PERMIT EXPIRATION.**

The General Permit will be scheduled for a permit writer to begin the renewal process in the near future. At that time the Division will contact you to inform you that permit renewal process has started. There may be outreach at that time to shareholders for input.

Based on the locational information provided in your application we have determined that your discharge would be to Segment: **COARMA06**. This discharge designation is solely for permit tracking and work planning purposes. The Division may evaluate other waterbody segments, particularly downstream segment(s), as part of the permit development process.
