Dear Mr. Brinton,

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (the Division) has finished reviewing the 2023 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Discharge Monitoring Reports for the McClane Canyon Mine. The reports were received electronically on November 8, 2023 (October DMRs), December 20, 2023 (November DMRs), and January 1, 2024 (December and quarterly DMRs). The reports cover the time period of October 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023. The Division finds the reports to be in compliance with Rule 4.05.13(2).

There are three outfalls associated with the CO-0038342 DMR permit, Outfall 001, Outfall 002 and Outfall 004. During the months of October, November and December, there was no discharge recorded from outfalls 001, 002 and 004. Therefore, no exceedances occurred.
