The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (the Division) received the New Horizon North Mine's submittal of required items for a Minor Revision on January 23, 2024. The information provided allowed the revision to be called complete on January 23, 2024. The Division has completed reviewing the application submittal for MR-37 and has the following adequacy comment.

1. The Minor Revision proposes a hay stackyard to be incorporated into the permit area by the landowner. The hay stackyard will be located in the southeast corner of the permit area. The information included on the proposed revised pages for Section 2.05.5(3) does not include the size of the stackyard. Please update this section to include the acreage that this proposed post-mining feature will be.
