Re: Extension Request, Inspection Problem Corrective Actions, Mary's Mountain Gravel Pit, Permit No. M-2003-068

Dear Ronald B. Montano,

On January 25, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received an extension request for the inspection problems cited in the Division's November 29, 2023 Inspection Report (see below).

INSPECTION TOPIC: Signs & Markers

PROBLEM: The mine identification sign and affected area boundary markers were not observed per the requirements of Rule 3.1.12.

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS:

- The Operator shall, at the entrance of the mine site post a sign, which shall be clearly visible from the access road, with a minimum size equaling one hundred and eighty-seven (187) square inches, such as eleven (11) inches in height and seventeen (17) inches in width, with appropriate font size, with the following: the name of the Operator, a statement that a reclamation permit for the operation has been issued by the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board; and the permit number. The Operator shall submit a photo via email of the posted sign by the corrective action date.
- The boundaries of the affected area must be marked by monuments or other markers that are clearly visible and adequate to delineate such boundaries. The Operator shall use the approved survey map included with the original permit application to replace the boundary markers. The Operator shall also submit photos and coordinates of the installed corner markers via email to the Division by the corrective action date.

The extension was requested to be set 60 days from the current January 29, 2024 due date. The Division **approves** your extension request. The new corrective actions date for the following inspection problems is set for **March 29, 2024**.
