On January 22, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Amendment application for the Two Rivers, which is located in Pueblo County. Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application complete and technical review can begin. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of February 1, 2024.

Per Rule 1.4.5(2)(b)(iii), an affidavit that notice signs were posted on-site pursuant to Rule 1.6.2(1)(b) is missing from application package.

Per Rule 6.4.16, Exhibit P should include a list of municipalities and the address of the general offices within two (2) miles of mining operation. The Town of Boone's general office address is not provided in Exhibit P.

You have sixty (60) days from February 1, 2024 to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for the application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, by April 8, 2024, the application has not been determined to be complete and filed, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
