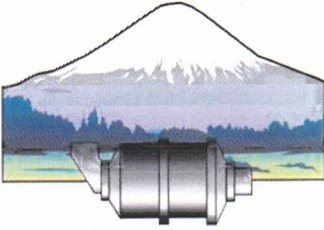

publication.

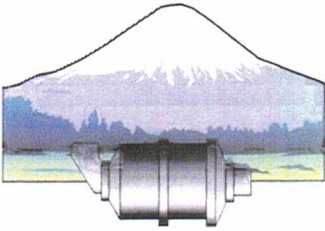
