On February 8, 2024 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) determined your 110d to 112d-1 Conversion Application (CN-3) complete for the purposes of filing. The Division has determination that the application is classified as "complex" and is extending the decision due date by an additional sixty (60) days, pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(7).
