RE: Preliminary Adequacy Review; Technical Revision (TR-2) – Reduction of Sampling Frequency and Analyte List; Knox Pit, Permit No. M-2017-036

Dear Mr. Fancher,

On February 2, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received your request for Technical Revision 2 (TR-2) to reduce the sampling frequency from quarterly to annually and a reduction of the analyte list for the site wide groundwater monitoring wells at the Knox Pit, Permit No. M-2017-036. The following clarification(s) or items need to be addressed to the Division's satisfaction.

1. The Operator is requesting to reduce the analyte list. Please provide a table that shows what is currently being sampled for at the site along with the proposed analyte list, please include the applicable Reg. 41 Table Value Standards.
2. Please provide time series graphs of all analytes for all wells, similar to Figures 1 and 2 included in the TR-2 application.
3. Please provide a summary table of site well data to date for the shallow groundwater quality similar to Table 1 in the Knox Pit Baseline Water Quality Evaluation (December 2019).

This concludes the Division's adequacy review of your application. The Division reserves the right to further supplement this document with additional adequacy items and/or details as necessary.

The decision date for your application is set for **March 3, 2024**. If additional time is needed to respond, an extension request must be received by our Office by the decision date. If on the decision date, outstanding adequacy items remain, and no extension request has been received, your revision may be denied and the file terminated.
