## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. This was a routine monitoring inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The inspection was focused on the following areas:

- Tenmile TSF and 3 Dam
- Mayflower TSF and 5 Dam

The Tenmile TSF and 3 Dam, and Mayflower TSF and 5 Dam were observed. No abnormal conditions were noted. TSF's appear to be functioning within the established design criteria.







5 Dam

Construction of the 5-Dam Seepwater Collection Area - Secondary Containment System that was approved through TR36 has been halted due to winter conditions and materials availability. Construction is anticipated to resume in May.



No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
