The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS or Division) received an application for the operation to enter into temporary cessation (TC2) pursuant to Rule 1.13 on February 7, 2024, the application was deemed complete and filed on February 8, 2024. The Division will place the Notice of Temporary Cessation on the regular agenda for the April 17 and 18, 2024 meeting of the Mined Land Reclamation Board (Board). During that meeting the Board will consider whether or not to accept the Notice. Please plan on attending the meeting of the Board. The meeting will be held in Room 318 of 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado, beginning at 9:00 a.m. on April 17, 2024 or as soon thereafter as the matter can be considered. In order to be considered at the hearing, all exhibits, materials and witness testimony you wish for the Board to consider must be submitted via email to the MLRB Administrator, Camie Mojar at: Camille.mojar@state.co.us, no later than 5:00 PM, April 12, 2024.

If you have good cause not to appear in person you may submit a request to the MLRB to appear virtually via (ZOOM). To do so, please submit an email to the MLRB Administrator, no later than 5:00 PM, April 12, 2024 for Board consideration. If approved you will receive an authorization code to attend the meeting for this matter. Please note that only Parties and those who will be testifying may attend by ZOOM.
