Re: Sheehan Pit, Permit No. M-2007-058, Notice of Past Due Financial Warranty Increase (TR-02)

Mr. Corson:

On December 6, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) issued a Financial Warranty increase with the approval of Technical Revision No. 2 (TR-02) to \$86,599.00 for the Sheehan Pit (see enclosed). This is an increase of \$35,129.00 from the currently held Financial Warranty of \$51,470.00. Pursuant to Rule 4.2.1(2) and C.R.S. 34-32.5-117(4)(c)(II), the additional required Financial Warranty was due within 60 days, by February 6, 2024. As of the date of this letter, the Division has not received the required increase.

Please submit the required additional Financial Warranty by **March 13, 2024**. This can be in the form of an amendment to the current Financial Warranty or submittal of a new Financial Warranty reflecting the increase. If, by the deadline above, the Division has not received the required increase, enforcement actions will be pursued which may include permit revocation, finding the currently held Financial Warranty subject to forfeiture, and the assessment of civil penalties.

On December 6, 2023 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety concluded its review of the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on October 1, 2023, addressing the following:

Operator has added into the Mining Plan that catch benches will be installed to keep rock from hitting County Rd 1. Also revised the Reclamation Plan as the catch benches will stay after reclamation. Maps have also been updated to show the location of the catch benches.

The decision reached by the Division is: approve.

The terms of Technical Revision No. 2 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-2007-058. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-2007-058 remain in full force and effect.

The revised liability amount exceeds the financial warranty currently held (see below), please submit additional bond or a rider to your existing bond that equals or exceeds the Revised Liability. The revision will not be final until the bond is approved by the Division.
