Patrick,

As you may know, CC&V received a substantial amount of snow over the weekend. Prior to the most recent storm, it is estimated that the Grassy Valley surface water monitoring locations were buried in 2.5' of snow. Per the Community Collaborative Rain, Hail and Snow Network (see below screenshots) this most recent storm brought another 36.5" of snow. CC&V estimates that snow depth within Grassy Valley is more than 5' (from the reported snow totals and visual estimation) and attempting to monitor surface water locations poses a safety hazard for Newmont personnel. CC&V is diligently working to re-establish safe access to all monitoring locations and will continually monitor the conditions in Grassy Valley. CC&V will update DRMS when the surface water monitoring locations are once again accessible for inspection. Please let me know if you have additional questions. Thank you!
