Re: Extension Request, Rocky Flat Gravel, Permit No. M-1982-129, Corrective Actions

Dear Mr. Goemmer,

Per a phone conversation with Lucas Dearmin on March 19, 2024, a request has been made for a 30 day extension to the corrective action dates for the following inspection problems for the Rocky Flat Gravel site (Permit No. M-1982-129) cited in the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division/DRMS) December 12, 2023 Inspection Report:

- **INSPECTION TOPIC:** Revegetation
PROBLEM: There are state-listed noxious weeds present on site. This is a problem for failure to employ weed control methods for state listed noxious weed species within the permitted area, and to reduce the spread of weeds to nearby areas as required by Section 3.1.10 (6) of the Rule.
CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: Implement approved weed control plan and provide proof to the Division that this has been done. The Operator shall provide proof to the Division that the weeds have been treated/removed by the corrective action date.
CORRECTIVE ACTION DUE DATE: 3/26/24
- **INSPECTION TOPIC:** Signs & Markers
PROBLEM: The affected area boundary markers are missing or incorrectly placed. This is a problem for failure to maintain boundary markers around the affected area as required by Section 3.1.12(2) of the rule.
CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: The Operator shall use the approved permit boundary map to replace the boundary markers in the correct location(s). The Operator shall provide proof to the Division that this has been done by the corrective action date.
CORRECTIVE ACTION DUE DATE: 3/26/24

The Division approves the extension request. The new corrective action date for these problems is set for **April 25, 2024**.
