

## **EXHIBIT M – OTHER PERMITS AND LICENSES**

The information provided in this Exhibit is intended to satisfy the requirements outlined in Section 6.4.13 of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board Construction Material Rules and Regulations:

The Operator either has or will obtain:

- **Pueblo County Special Use Permit** – MM has obtained a Special Use Permit for Gravel Mining.
- **Pueblo County Floodplain Use Permit** – MM will obtain a County Floodplain Use Permit.
- **Pueblo County Erosion Control and Sediment Control Plan** – MM will apply to Pueblo County for an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan.
- **Well Permit and Substitute Water Supply Plan** – A Substitute Water Supply Plan and gravel pit well permit will be obtained from the State Engineer's Office. Well permits for monitoring wells will also be obtained.
- **APEN, Colorado Department of Health and Environment Air Pollution Emission Notification Permit** – Permits will be obtained prior to operations.
- **CDPS, Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment Colorado Discharge Permit System Permit, COG 500000** – Permits will be obtained prior to operations.
- **U.S. EPA** - Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure (SPCC) Plan.
- **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers** – A Jurisdictional Determination (JD) or nationwide permit will be obtained prior to disturbing wetlands at the site.
