# **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate conditions observed.

The Lindsey Canyon LLC site is located approximately 5.75 miles southwest of Montrose and accessed from Old Lindsey Canyon Trail Road. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 9.5 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$20,460.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by posts and fencing that was clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

The pit is excavated to a depth of approximately 10 feet. The pit wall on the west is graded to approximately 3H:1V. The remainder of the pit slopes, approximately 1,000 linear feet, have sloughed to roughly 1H:1V. Several construction material stockpiles are located in the pit, along with several pieces of excavation equipment. Approximately 3 acres are currently disturbed.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
