Good afternoon, Jocelyn.

I believe TR-06 addressed the seed mix. The landowner is working to establish the seed mix, but it is not finalized yet. TR06 committed to submitting that mix prior to reclamation. We have yet to seed the backfilled portions of Phase II. The Adequacy Review #3 of that TR application also addressed that Phase III was to be reclaimed as wetlands and not water storage as indicated in your review.

Would it be best to talk through TR06, as that one had a lot of moving parts. This TR is simply asking to begin removing overburden for backfill in a previous phase. In TR-06, Fremont committed to notifying the state 60 days prior to any disturbance on that site.

I have availability tomorrow morning to discuss further and find a path forward. If you aren't available, I can send over an extension request.
