Detailed description of the issue(s) * (?)  Please provide as much detail as possible. It is important to narrow down the issue(s).  A mining operation appears to have begun where there is not a permit (that I am aware of). It seems to be in		
the parking lot area near the trailhead at the top of Rapid Creek Road. I have photos of an excavator digging and loading a 24-ton semi, and three ten-ton dump trucks. There is not a scale in use, so these loaded trucks are possibly overloaded, careening down difficult mountain roads, through a residential area with considerable pedestrian traffic. There is no traffic control when a tractor-trailer weighing over 110,000 pounds drives up and down this narrow gravel / paved road (Rapid Creek Road).  I would also like to ask why this mining operation is being allowed without any public hearing, without public notice, and without a mining permit. Excavation on this parcel has been taking place since the beginning of April 2024.		
I recommend a cease and desist order be applied immediately to the havoc they are creating until a public hearing has commenced; they get proper permitting through the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety; and post a reclamation bond for the ugliness they are creating in my neighborhood.
