RE: Wray Trailer Park Expansion, Reference No. M-2024-013 "Is It Mining?" Questionnaire, Additional Information Required

Mr. Weaver:

On April 1, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) received your "Is It Mining?" questionnaire regarding a proposed sandy loam and caliche excavation located on private property in Yuma County. Approximately 5,400 cubic yards of material will be extracted from the site for use in a trailer park expansion. The proposed extraction area will cover 1.1 acres, with a depth of approximately 6-1/2 feet.

In order for DRMS to make a determination as to whether a Mined Land Reclamation Permit is required for your proposed project, the following additional information is needed:

- 1) Please submit a site map that clearly shows the location of the proposed extraction site, as requested under Item #1 of the questionnaire. Please also show on this map the location(s) where the extracted material will be taken for the trailer park expansion project. (This map can be in the form of a Google Earth image of the site.)
- 2) Under Item #5 of the questionnaire, you state the extracted material will be used on the same parcel of property where the material is extracted. Please describe any roads that will be used to transport the material from the extraction area to the trailer park expansion project. Will any public roads need to be crossed or used to transport the material from the extraction site to the trailer park expansion area?
