Responsibilities as a Permittee:

Upon application approval and permit issuance, this application becomes a legally binding document. Therefore, there are a number of important requirements which you, as a permittee, should fully understand. These requirements are listed below. Your obligation to reclaim the site is not limited to the amount of the financial warranty. You assume legal liability for all reasonable expenses which the Board or the Office may incur to reclaim the affected lands associated with your mining operation in the event your permit is revoked and financial warranty is forfeited;



The Board may suspend or revoke this permit, or assess a civil penalty, upon a finding that the permittee violated the terms or conditions of this permit, the Act, the Mineral Rules and Regulations, or that information contained in the application or your permit misrepresent important material facts;



If your mining and reclamation operations affect areas beyond the boundaries of an approved permit boundary, substantial civil penalties, to you as permittee can result:



Any modification to the approved mining and reclamation plan from those described in your approved application requires you to submit a permit modification and obtain approval from the Board or Office;



It is your responsibility to notify the Office of any changes in your address or phone number;



Upon permit issuance and prior to beginning on-site mining activity, you must post a sign at the entrance of the mine site, which shall be clearly visible from the access road, with the following information (Rule 3.1.12):

- the name of the operator; a.
- a statement that a reclamation permit for the operation has been issued by the Colorado Mined Land b. Reclamation Board; and,
- the permit number.



The boundaries of the permit boundary area must be marked by monuments or other markers that are clearly visible and adequate to delineate such boundaries prior to site disturbance;



It is a provision of this permit that the operations will be conducted in accordance with the terms and conditions listed in your application, as well as with the provisions of the Act and the Mineral Rules and Regulations in effect at the time the permit is issued.



Annually, on the anniversary date of permit issuance, you must submit an annual fee as specified by Statute, and an annual report which includes a map describing the acreage affected and the acreage reclaimed to date (if there are changes from the previous year), any monitoring required by the Reclamation Plan to be submitted annually on the anniversary date of the permit approval. Annual fees are for the previous year a permit is held. For example, a permit with the anniversary date of July 1, 1995, the annual fee is for the period of July 1, 1994 through June 30, 1995. Failure to submit your annual fee and report by the permit anniversary date may result in a civil penalty, revocation of your permit, and forfeiture of your financial warranty. 

Exhibit E Reclamation plan

The reclamation plan is for approximately 20-18yd loads of material hauled in from our Deterding pit will be placed in the mined area using a Dozer to obtain the 3:1 slope required, when the mined area is filled to proper level to obtain the 3:1 slope topsoil will be placed over the top of the imported material At a depth of 4-6 inches to help assure vegetation growth and not be near as venerable to wind erosion as the native sand. After the topsoil is in place the existing vegetation that is shown in the shaded area of the reclamation map will be pulled back on the topsoil using an excavator. Upon finishing the moving of the existing vegetation, we will seed/fertilize with a mix as shown in this application. After seeding/fertilizing is done we will water with a water truck to help growth begin.
