I am pleased to report that Cross Caribou Mines successfully maintained full control of our operations despite the extreme weather events and the power outages enacted by Excel Energy.

With our underground storage capability, we captured and securely held all waters within the lower levels of the Cross Mine. We maintained complete control of all effluent waters and prevented any unauthorized discharges.

Currently, our systems are operating at full capacity, with no incidents of effluent escape or negative impacts on our compliance status as a result of this event.
