Dear Mr. Fourney,

Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association Inc. (Tri-State), is the parent company to Elk Ridge Mining and Reclamation, LLC (ERMR), New Horizon Mine. Therefore, Tri-State on behalf of the New Horizon Mine is notifying you that New Horizon Mine submitted an application for Phase I, II, and III performance bond release for five backfill monitoring wells and seven exploratory drill holes. This application for Phase I, II, and III bond release, when submitted, was designated as SL-28.

When ERMR submitted the SL-28 application, it was still the landowner of record for one the backfill monitoring wells that was on ERMR property. Since the SL-28 application was submitted, ERMR sold the property to you.
