MineWater LLC has applied for a Limited Impact (110) reclamation permit from the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board (the "Board") to conduct sand and gravel mining operations in Park County. The attached information is being provided to notify you of the location and nature of the proposed operation. The entire application is on file with the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (the "Division") and at the local county clerk and recorder.

The applicant/operator proposes to reclaim the affected land to recreation use. Pursuant to Section 34-32.5-116(4)(m), C.R.S., the Board may confer with the local Board of County Commissioners before approving of the post-mining land use. Accordingly, the Board would appreciate your comments on the proposed operation. Please note that, in order to preserve your right to a hearing before the Board on this application, you must submit written comments on the application within ten (10) days after the date of the applicant's newspaper publication.
