Mr. Perkins:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) has denied your NOI application. As you know there is a previously issued permit, M-1999-074, for the Brown Derby Mine, that is still active. The permit was issued to Precious Offerings Mineral Exchange, Inc. October 20, 1999. The area for which you have staked mining claims has also been staked by the current permittee.

The Division, nor BLM, has jurisdiction regarding rival claimant disputes. These matters should be resolved by private litigation. However, the Division does have an obligation to ensure an applicant has legal right to enter a property for mining and reclamation purposes before approving an NOI application and authorizing prospecting operations. Because there are multiple claimants for the Brown Derby mine the validity of your proof of right of entry is uncertain at this time and should be verified through private litigation.

You may submit another application at a future date if your claim ownership can be verified.

The Division has terminated your application and your financial warranty check, in the amount of \$2,000, will be returned to you under separate cover.



LOCATING AND RECORDING A MINING CLAIM

After a mineral deposit has been discovered, land ownership has been verified, and it's been verified that no current claim exists on the land, the land may be claimed. The process of staking a claim is listed above and includes placing posts or monuments at the corner of the claim along with a location notice. A copy of the claim notice must be filed with the proper state BLM office within 90 days of the date of location.

From Colorado BLM:

DETERMINING LAND STATUS Prior to locating a claim or even doing extensive prospecting, one should determine whether the area is open to location. **It is not open to location if the land is private property or is covered by patented or unpatented mining claims.**

From Nevada State publication:

To determine whether the ground is covered by unpatented claims, the area should be searched for monuments used to mark claims or for location notices.

It is important to both physically inspect the area of interest and review the records with caution, because there may be times when a valid claim exists but not all the monumentation and records are in place. As will be discussed in more detail later, the locator has 90 days after posting a notice of location to erect all the necessary monumentation.

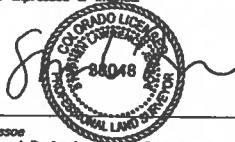

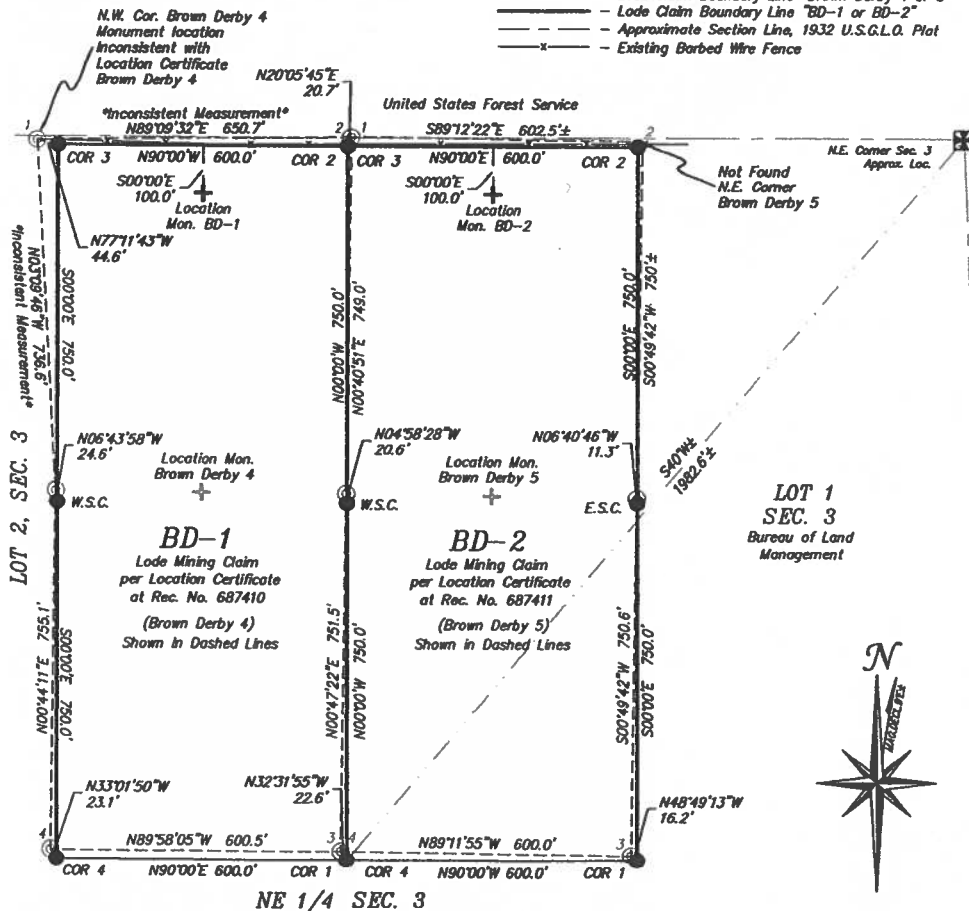

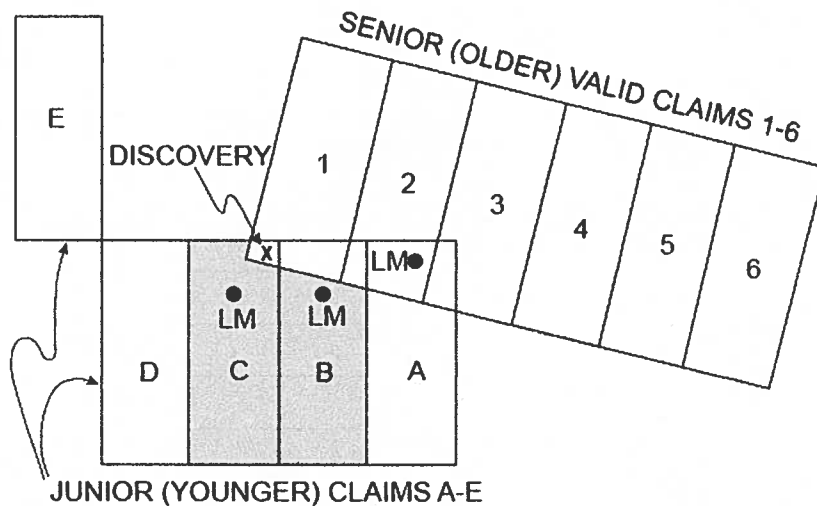

A duplicate copy of the notice of location may be filed promptly with the County Recorder to give better legal protection, but this is not required by law. Persons other than the locator may be present during the location procedure, and they can sign the notice of location as witnesses; however, witnesses are not required by Nevada law. Putting a false date on a notice of location or making a false material statement on a certificate of location or a map renders the claim void and is a Class D felony and is punishable by imprisonment for a minimum term of 1 year and a maximum term of not more than 4 years. In addition to any penalty the court may impose a fine of not more than \$5,000 (NRS 193.130; NRS 517.300).

MARKING BOUNDARIES

Nevada State law (NRS 517.030) requires that the locator must define the boundaries of the lode claim by placing a monument at each corner within 60 days from the date of location (fig. 1). If the side lines are not straight, a monument should be placed at each bend. Boundary monuments can be placed on ground already claimed, but the location monument and the discovery must be on ground open to location (fig. 2). According to Nevada State law (NRS 517.030) the monuments may consist of any of the following:

- A. A blazed and marked tree, with top removed and minimum diameter
