On May 16, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the Technical Revision application (TR-11) to address the reclamation of the South Bank slope. The schedule decision date for the TR-11 is June 15, 2024. Please address the following adequacy issues identified by the Division prior to this decision date.

1. The updated maps submitted do not meet requirements outlined in Rule 6.2.1(2). The following items need to be added to the maps:
 - a. The preparer's signature, per sub-paragraph (b).
 - b. A scale and a north arrow, per sub-paragraph (e).

This concludes the preliminary adequacy review for the TR-11 application. The Division reserves the right to further supplement this document with additional adequacy items and/or details as necessary.

As stated above, the decision date for the TR-11 application is scheduled for June 15, 2024. If additional time is necessary to address the above issues, a request to extend the decision date must be submitted to the Division prior to the decision date.
