On March 18, 2024 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received the Application Form for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators from IHC Scott, Inc. to W.W. Clyde & Co., for the Piceance Pit, Permit M-2001-077. Additional materials were received on June 4, 2024. The following items are incomplete for the application to be processed:

Application Form

1. The notary on pages 9 is incorrect. The full company name for the permittee is IHC Scott, Inc. W.W. Clyde & Co. was entered as the company name for both signatures. There's no need to resubmit page 10 since the Division can accept counterpart signatures. **Correct documentation was received however it was a copy not an original notary.**

Please return the required documentation to the Division **before June 7, 2024**. The Bond for IHC Scott, Inc. expires on July 31, 2024. If SO-5 is not completed by June 7, 2024 the Division may begin enforcement proceedings.
