Hi Nikie,

I just left you a voice mail regarding a resident's (neighbor) questions concerning the Bennett Pit and the recent transfer of ownership. Most of her questions are within the scope of DRMS regulations and permit, including the following:

1. Is the new owner, Martin Marietta, required to notify nearby property owners of the mine's change in ownership? If so, is the type of notification specified? (*County land use regulations do not require such*).
2. There has been standing water in the bottom of the pit since last spring. Is this allowed per the DRMS permit? (*County CUP only requires mosquito control for accumulated water areas*).

Also, Miles Buescher is no longer with the County and we have a new Environmental Compliance Specialist, Jaclyn Gomez, starting tomorrow. Once she has completed the requisite MSHA training, I would love to coordinate a joint inspection with you as she learns the "ropes".
