COMMENTS

This was an aerial inspection of the Hayden Gulch Loadout operated by Hayden Gulch Termnal, LLC. The photos were taken and evaluated by Brock Bowles with the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division).

The weather was clear on the day of inspection. No mining activity was occurring on site at the time of inspection and no operator representative accompanied the inspection.

The areas remaining in the permit are the fields directly north and south of Hwy 40, to be reclaimed to agricultural use as hay fields.

RECLAMATION SUCCESS - Rule 4.15, Rule 3:

The area between the trailhead parking lot and highway 40 is starting to sprout for the season (photo 1). The grass appears to be less well developed on the east side of the reclaimed area but overall looks good. A sewer line is being installed immediately north and parallel to the powerlines. The sewer line construction crosses the reclamation in this area. The sewer line is a project of the Town of Hayden and is not mine related.

The area between Hwy 40 and the railroad is also starting to sprout (photo 2). The vegetation appears to be more well developed on the southern portion of the reclamation.
