Dear Jeff Jacoby:

On July 1, 2024, the Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety (Division) received corrective action for the problem identified in the Division's April 23, 2024 inspection report:

INSPECTION TOPIC: Reclamation Success

PROBLEM/POSSIBLE VIOLATION: Problem: The site is utilizing off-site fill without prior approval by the Division per 3.1.5(9) of the Rule

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: The operator shall provide a Technical Revision with a notarized affidavit, stating that the fill is, in fact, inert and addressing all requirements pursuant to Rule 3.1.5(9), which describes the intended use of inert/off-site fill by the corrective action date.

CORRECTIVE ACTION STATUS: Abated. TR-6 was filed on July 1, 2024. This TR is for temporary storage of approximately 38,000 cy of imported fill dirt (mainly subsoil) on pit floor to be used for a housing development adjacent to the permit area.
