## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted in response to the citizen complaint that was received from John Connel on May 14, 2024. The complaint alleges that there is an unpermitted mining operation at the site.

"Mining/gravel pit operation taking place inside a residential development. Numerous dust/noise complaints. Located within 100 ft of a stream in a flood plain."

The site is located within the Waterfall Canyon development, on the west side Montrose, at approximately 38.466321°, -107.905135°. This is a new subdivision under construction. As part of the development, a number of ponds have been created. This has resulted in production of extraneous gravel and fill material that was observed on site. Extraction of this construction material appears incidental to the construction project. There does not appear to be a mining operation at this location.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
