## RE: Rudder Pit (Permit No. M-2019-008) Succession of Operator No. 1 (SO-1) Incomplete Application

Dear Mr. Rudder:

On July 3, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your Succession of Operator 1 Application package for the Rudder Pit, File No. M-2019-008.

Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following items must be received before the Division can consider you application as being submitted and a technical review can begin:

- 1. Performance Warranty: The submitted document wasn't acceptable. Page 9 wasn't dated which invalids the signatures and notary.
- 2. Affidavit of Authority: The submitted document wasn't acceptable. The full company name "Rudder Brothers LLC" must be used in each blank for company name.
- 3. Financial Warranty: A bond in the amount of \$5,270.00 is required along with Financial Warranty paperwork. This paperwork varies depending on payment type (check, cd, letter of credit, corporate surety). Please let me know your method of payment & I can email you the correct paperwork.
- 4. Rudder Brothers LLC is "delinquent" with the CO Sec. of State. Before any bond can be accepted, Rudder Brothers LLC must be in good standing. Please make arrangements with the CO Sec. of State.

Your SO1 application will not be considered submitted/filed until the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin the review.

Pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(8), you have sixty (60) days from the date of this letter to submit all necessary documents that the DRMS needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the DRMS, the DRMS may deny the application and terminate the application file

The response to this Incompleteness Notice is due on or before September 9, 2024.

This letter shall not be interpreted to mean that there are no other completeness issues or technical deficiencies in your application. The DRMS will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
