Dear Mr. Murphy:

On July 12, 2024, the Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety (Division) received your request to extend the corrective action date for the following problem identified in the Division's August 3, 2023 inspection report:

INSPECTION TOPIC: Revegetation/ Noxious Weeds

PROBLEM #2: There are state-listed noxious weeds present on site. This is a problem for failure to employ weed control methods for state-listed noxious weed species within the permitted area, and to reduce the spread of weeds to nearby areas as required by Rule 3.1.10(6).

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: The operator shall submit evidence (invoice for service, receipt of chemical purchase, and/or images of sprayed plants) to the Division of implementation of the approved weed control plan by the corrective action due date.

NEW CORRECTIVE ACTION DUE DATE: August 12, 2024
