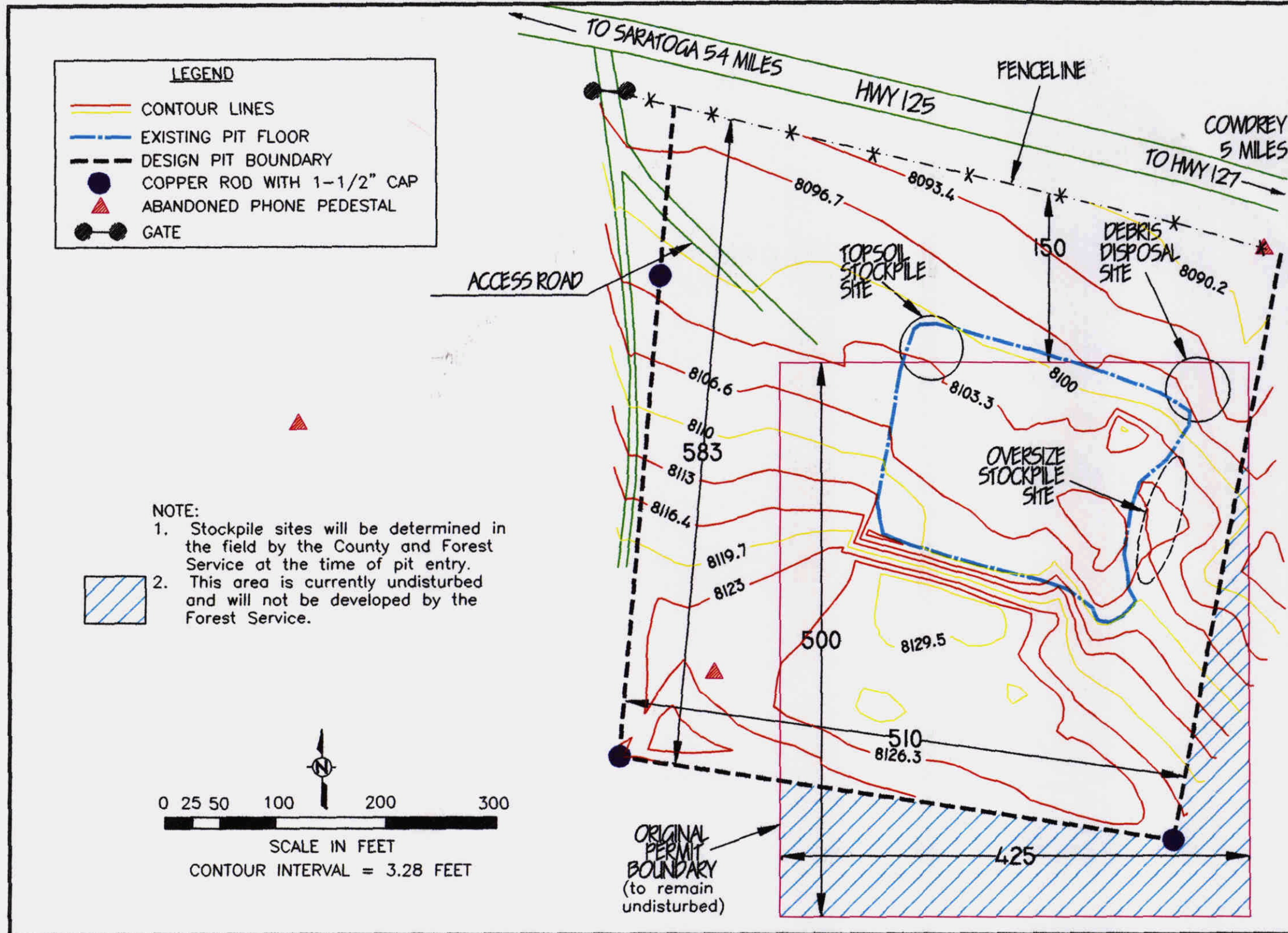


EXHIBIT C — Mining Plan



EXCAVATION AND DEVELOPMENT REQUIREMENTS

PRIOR TO ENTRY:

- The limits of the permit area shall be clearly marked.
- Signing shall be erected to warn the public of hauling activities.

DURING EXCAVATION:

- Carefully strip, stockpile, and seed all available topsoil for use in pit rehabilitation.
- Excavate and shape pit as shown on the drawings and staked in the field. Final pit slopes shall not exceed 3:1.
- No equipment shall be operated outside the established permit area limits.
- Excavation shall proceed in a manner that promotes continuation of existing ground surface drainage patterns.
- Mining will begin on the north slope of the existing pit excavation and expand in a southerly direction.
- Existing one lane access road will be utilized, approx. 300 feet long and 9-10 feet wide. No new roads will be required.
