The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (the Division) has finished reviewing the 2024 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Discharge Monitoring Reports for the McClane Canyon Mine. The reports were received electronically on February 5, 2024 (January DMRs), March 4, 2024 (February DMRs), and April 1, 2024 (March and quarterly DMRs). The reports cover the time period of January 1, 2024 through March 31, 2024. The Division finds the reports to be in compliance with Rule 4.05.13(2).

There are three outfalls associated with the CO-0038342 DMR permit, Outfall 001, Outfall 002 and Outfall 004. During the months of January, February and March, there was no discharge recorded from outfalls 001, 002 and 004. Therefore, no exceedances occurred.
