<u>Re</u>: Turnpike Mining Resource (M-2004-009) – May 10, 2024 Inspection Corrective Actions Completed, Request to Extend Due Date for Re-seeding, and Request to Complete Grading of Drainage Ditch as Part of Overall Site Reclamation

Ms. Gagnon:

Please find the list below and attached photograph log documenting the corrective actions Asphalt Specialties Co., Inc. (ASCI) has completed for Problem #1 as required in the inspection report from the May 10, 2024 inspection of the Turnpike Mining Resource (M-2004-009).

Completed Corrective Actions:

1. Contact the adjacent landowner and obtain permission to clean out the culvert. Ensure the work is done to the landowner's satisfaction.

2. Clean out the material that was placed into the ditch to restore flow.

5. The Operator shall work with the adjacent landowner to obtain access permission for the repair work outside the permit area and minimize additional disturbance to the adjacent land.

6. The Operator shall provide proof to the Division that this work has been done by the corrective action date (i.e., this document, as applicable).

As shown in the attached photograph log, ASCI restored the culvert flow capabilities, removed all mud, and repaired/re-graded the slope to all impacted portions of Mr. Schell's property.

Extension Request to Complete Corrective Action "4. Seed the repaired slope to reestablish vegetation.":

Other than seeding, all restoration work on Mr. Schell's property is complete. Due to the hot and dry summer we are experiencing, ASCI respectfully requests an extension to complete Corrective Action "4. Seed the repaired slope to reestablish vegetation." on the impacted areas of Mr. Schell's property until this fall when conditions will be better suited for successful vegetative growth. Per an on-site conversation with Mr. Schell on 8/1/2024, Mr. Schell indicated that he was acceptable with ASCI re-seeding this fall or winter.

Per the "Planting Tips for Grasses" document published by the Colorado State University Extension - Boulder County Extension, the planting window for non-irrigated plantings begins October 15 (for Mountains) and November 15 (for Plains). ASCI is requesting an extension to the due date to complete the reseeding of Mr. Schell's property within the October 15th to November 15th window (to be completed no later than Friday, November 15, 2024).

Request to Complete Corrective Action #3 as Part of Overall Site Reclamation:

ASCI has cleaned out all material that was placed in the drainage ditch and restored ditch flow (i.e., Corrective Action 2). As shown in the photograph log, ASCI has regraded the ditch to a 3:1 slope on both sides from the southern extent of mud impacts to just south of the temporary crossing (>400 feet estimated). However, even though historic slopes of the drainage ditch are not 3:1, the re-grading of drainage ditch slopes impacted by mining activities (including slopes beyond the extent of mud impacts) may be needed as part of overall Site reclamation. To accomplish this, ASCI will need to retain access to our property on the eastern side of the ditch. ASCI is proposing to leave the temporary crossing in place to facilitate access to the east side of the ditch on our property during overall reclamation of the Site, but the temporary crossing will be removed and slopes re-graded prior to completing final Site reclamation.

As discussed, since the drainage ditch is located on ASCI property and the drainage ditch is functional, ASCI respectfully requests to be able to complete Problem #1 Corrective Action "3. *Grade the slope to 3H:1V and blend with the contours of the natural drainage.*" during the overall Site reclamation period since additional grading of ditch slopes beyond the extent of mud impacts may be necessary.
