I am writing to address item 1 from the adequacy question for the agencies' Q1 review of Stoner Engineering's Q1 Waste Pile/Embankment Inspection. As per the inspection's recommendations, maintenance was completed on the upper section of Reach 10 along the existing slope of the upper refuse pile. To mitigate the flow from the upper refuse and reduce the risk of future erosion, check dams were also installed using river rock. This work was completed in the second week of April.

Additionally, further measures were taken in July to address the storm events highlighted in Stoner Engineering's Q2 Waste Pile/Embankment Inspection.
