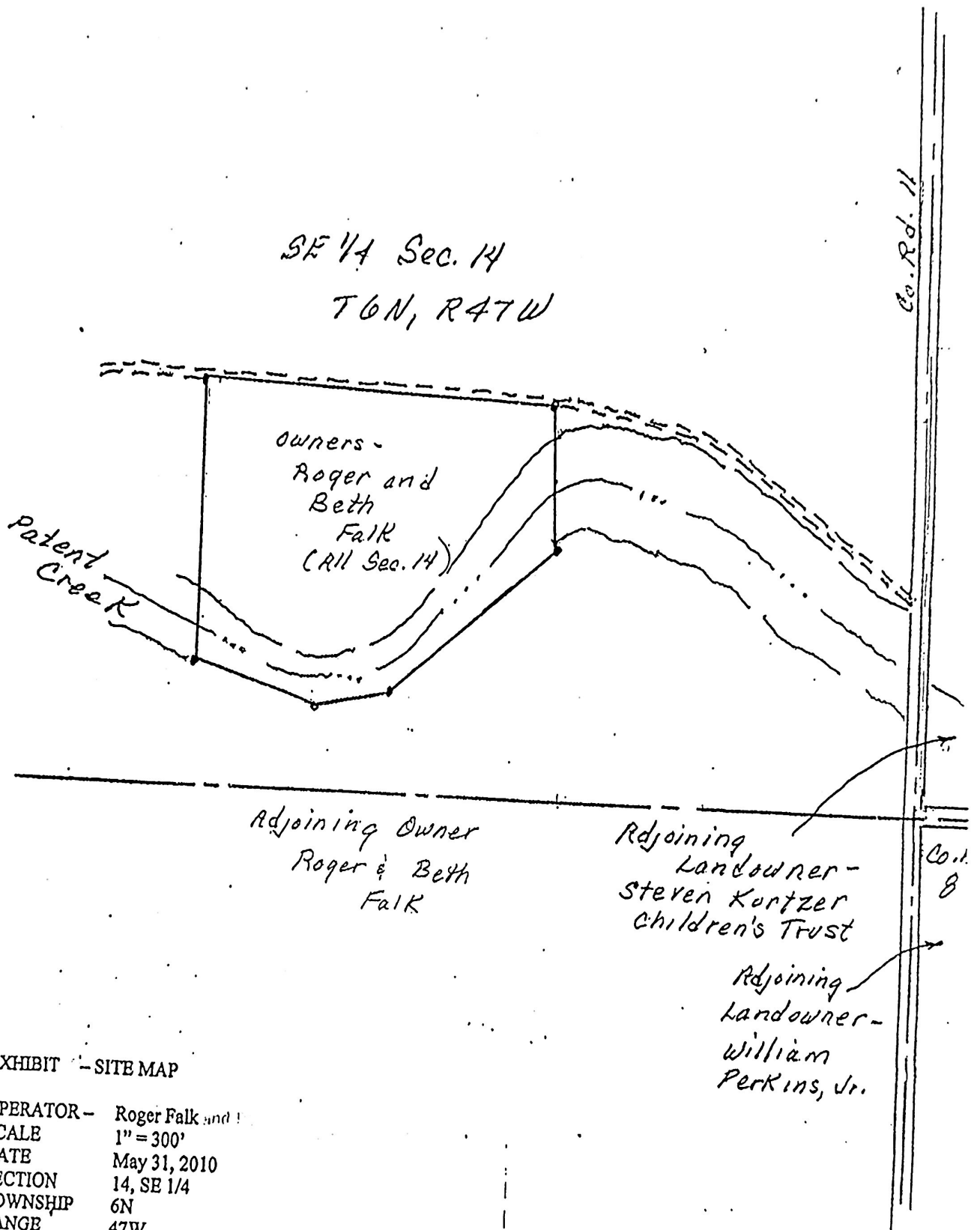
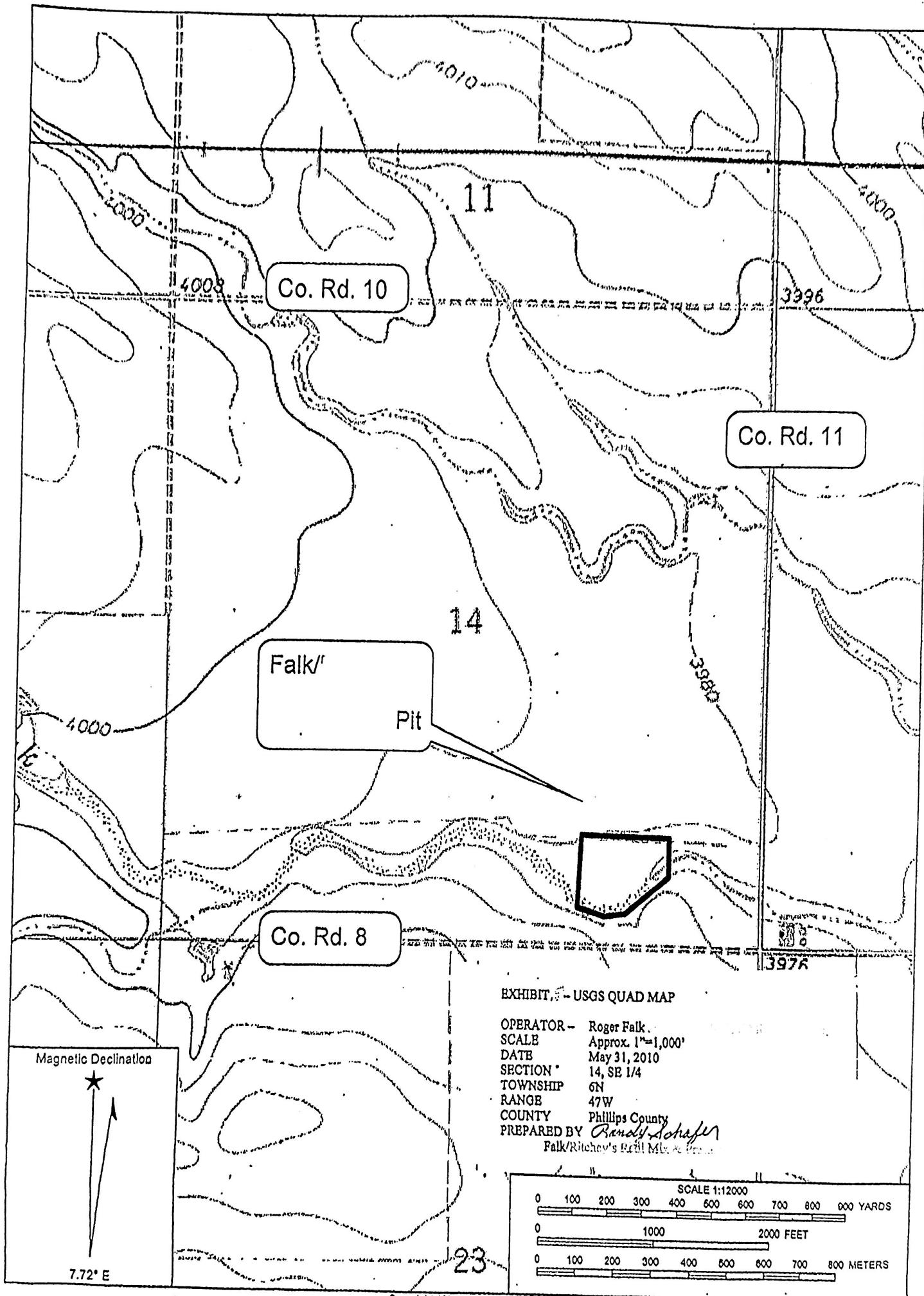


EXHIBIT - SITE MAP

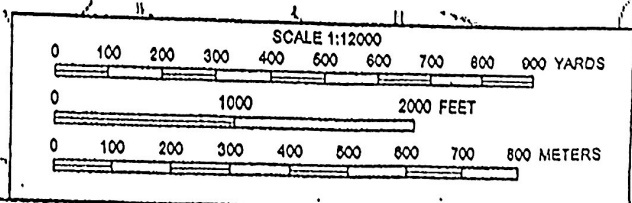

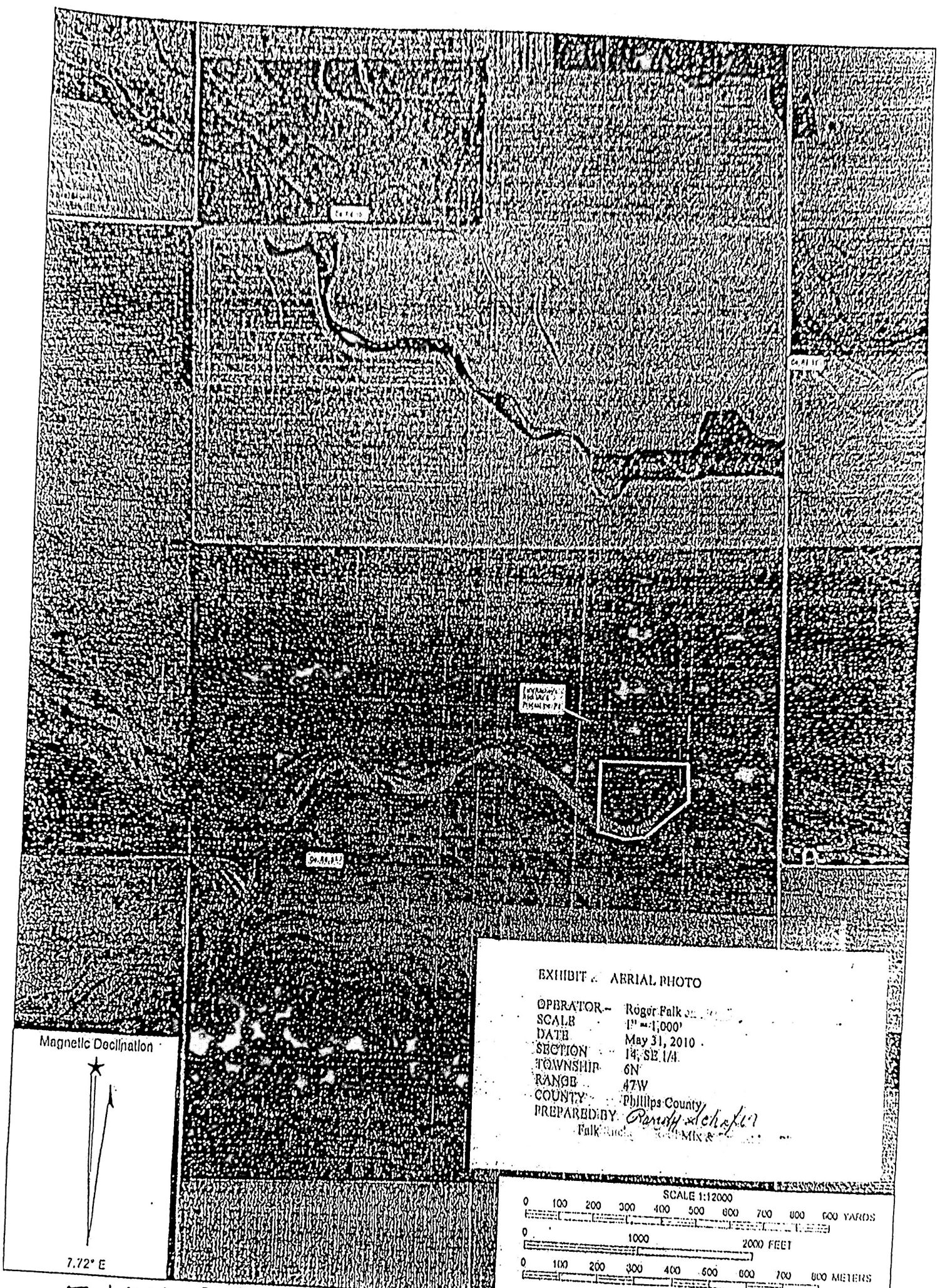

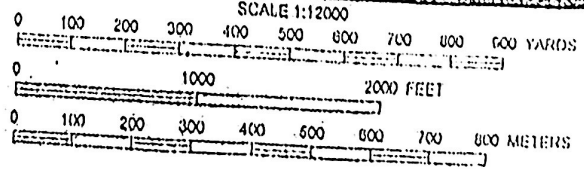

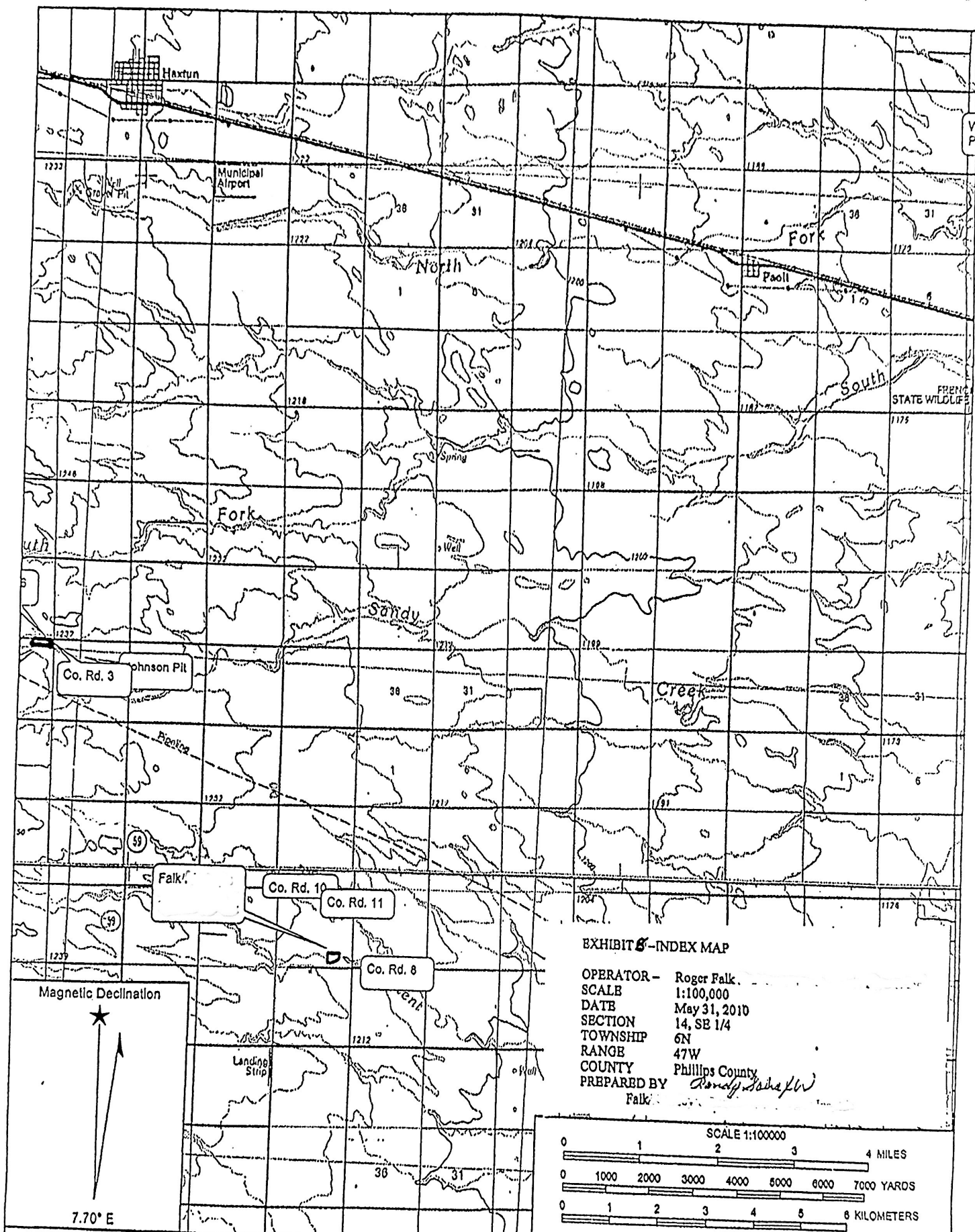


EXHIBIT B-INDEX MAP
