Mr. Patrick Lennberg

In accordance with the approved CN-01 for the Gold Hill Mill permit, Colorado Milling Company is working to recertify the Tailings Storage Facility located onsite. This process has been delayed due to health issues to Colorado Milling Company management. Please see the attached email from Mark Steen regarding that issue.

Nonetheless, Colorado Milling Company is working to address the requirement for recertification of the Tailings Storage Facility. The recertification work currently includes two components: a survey of the entire Facility embankment, with the establishment of known points that can be repeatedly capture in follow up surveys to monitor for embankment settling and thus maintain Facility capacity. The second component of the recertification is the determination of the integrity of the liner below the tailings material currently in the Facility. Colorado Milling Company is working with geophysical investigation firms to develop a way to evaluate the liner integrity using geophysical methods such as resistivity measurements. Prior to deployment of this technique, Colorado Milling Company will submit the proposed study to CDRMS for concurrence.
