Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the Bowie No. 1 Mine. The application was deemed complete on August 22, 2024.

Bowie Resources proposes to remove the first three-hundred feet of the Farmers Ditch culvert at the loadout, restore the ditch in that segment, and reclaim the sediment pond. This is interim reclamation prior to final reclamation of the entire culvert. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
