On August 26, 2024 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received the Application Form for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators from W.W. Clyde & Co. to Flintstone, LLC, for the Piceance Pit, Permit M-2001-077. The following items are incomplete for the application to be processed:

Application Form/Fee

1. Incorrect application fee submitted. \$115 was submitted which is the Hard Rock fee amount. This is a Construction Materials site and the SO fee is \$144. Please submit the remaining \$29.

Structure Agreement

2. Provide the Division copies of agreements to compensate the owners of any significant, valuable, and permanent man-made structures and utilities within 200 feet of the affected land ("Structure Agreements"). See attached from. If none, include a statement of such.

Other

3. Please submit an affidavit of Authority. Form attached.



Please be aware that once the request is filed the Division will conduct a site inspection and determine the required Financial Warranty amount. A replacement bond must be submitted prior to the permit being transferred.

Please return the required documentation to the Division **before October 28, 2024**. All completed permit documents are required to be submitted for consideration of your Request for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators Application. An incomplete application may be denied after the 60 day submittal request, if requested documents or information are not received.
