Today, the division received the adequacy responses for Technical Revision No. 66 (TR-66).

The Division has the following adequacy items that must be addressed prior to our approval of TR-66.

- 2. On Map 07, please clarify the symbology for SAEs. It appears that green hatching is used in some locations but not other locations. Please check that all symbology is correct and consistent on this map.

This is still not clear on the revised map. It appears that green hatching is used to show features such as grass filters or other BMPs. Should the hatching illustrate the SAEs themselves? To the Division, SAEs are the drainage areas above the sediment control best management practices (BMPs), not just the BMPs. Please update the map to clearly show the SAE areas and include different symbols for grass filters and other BMPs.
