## Re: Final Extension Approval, Due Date for Submitting Corrective Actions for Problems Cited in November 2023, Parsons Mine, Permit No. M-2009-082

Dear Ms. Mikulas,

On August 30, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received your request to extend the due date for submitting corrective actions for problems cited in the inspection report and subsequent problem citation letter from November 2023 at the Parsons Mine, Permit File No. M-2009-082. The Operator has had ample time to revise the Mining and Reclamation Plan Maps, revise the narrative for Exhibits D and E, and update Exhibit L to reflect existing and proposed activities at the site. It is noted the oil and gas wells were being removed as early as 2018 and at that time the Operator was notified of the needed map revisions to account for their removal. The Operator is requesting an extension to the decision date from August 30 to October 30, 2024. The Division will only approve an extension of the due date to October 4, 2024.

If the Operator is unable to submit the requested updated information, as required by the problem citations, by that date the Division will use existing information in the permit file to calculate a new financial warranty and issue any required surety increase on that date.
