This letter, as required by Rule 3.03.2(5)(a) of the Rules and Regulations, is to inform you that the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has issued a proposed decision to approve Bond Release Application No. 12 for the Keenesburg Strip Mine. This decision will be published in the *Fort Lupton Press* as soon as possible. The first day following publication of the notice initiates a thirty (30) day public comment period. If, within thirty days, there are no requests for an adjudicatory hearing, the decision will become final.

The Division holds a Corporate Surety bond issued by your company (Bond No. *9990), for this operation in the amount of \$818,446.00. The proposed release amount is (\$131,386.00).
