





I am a consulting engineer working on a Connell Resources sand and gravel mine in the NW corner of Larimer County roads 5 and 36 (see 811 map), Larimer County, Colorado. The CenturyLink map I received from my 811 submittal (Ticket #A312400703) shows CenturyLink assets on 3 sides of the project area. None of these assets are an issue for the sand and gravel mine, but I am required by law to map all utilities in the area and send notification of the project activities to utility owners.
