Dear Mr. Duncan:

On August 6, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division) received your request for a full release of the financial warranty and termination of the above referenced NOI. The release request in conjunction with the submitted final abandonment reports meets the requirements of Rule 4.16.1. It is noted that the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has been noticed of the request as well.

Per Rule 4.16.1(3) the Division shall within 30 days of receiving said report, or as soon thereafter as weather conditions permit, inspect the lands and reclamation to determine if the operator has complied with all applicable requirements. This letter is to inform you that current ground conditions and access prevent the inspection of the site. Therefore an inspection will be scheduled as soon as weather and ground conditions allow. Staff will communicate with the BLM when weather improves to see which course of action will take place.
