1st Quarter 2024 Discharge Monitoring Reports Review**

Dear Ms. Hammond,

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (the Division) has finished reviewing the 2024 1st Quarter Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs). The reports cover the time period of January 1, 2024 through March 31, 2024. The Division finds the reports to be in compliance with Rules:

- **Rule 4.05.13(2)(i)** – Samples are measured accurately and record the quality and quantity of the water discharged from the permit area.
- **Rule 4.05.13(2)(ii)** – There are two outfalls associated with the CO-0027146 NPDES permit, Outfall 002 and Outfall 016. During the months of January, February and March no flow was recorded out of Outfall 002. No exceedances occurred at this location. Outfall 016 discharged during all three months of the 1st quarter. The reports indicate that no exceedances occurred for the reported parameters during the 1st quarter. No other concerns were identified during this time period.
- **Rule 4.05.13(2)(iii)** – Discharge Monitoring Reports are received on a quarterly basis and filed with the Division within 90 days of the sample collection. The reports were received on; February 8, 2024 (January report), March 7, 2024 (February report) and April 8, 2024 (March and 1st quarter reports).
