OBSERVATIONS

This was a monitoring inspection conducted by Ben Hammar and Zach Trujillo of DRMS as part of DRMS' regular monitoring program. The site entrance is located approximately 1.5 miles north of W 68th Ave on the east side of Highway 93 in Jefferson County.

The permitted land is owned by the City of Arvada. The Division approved AR1 in July of 2019, which reduced the permitted area to roughly 94 acres of land in active reclamation. The majority of the permit has been released as rangeland, with some sections being leased to Pioneer. No mining has been performed on this site since 2014, and reclamation of the remaining area is nearing completion.

Regrading and revegetation of the remaining area has been successfully completed, with only a small section of relatively barren space existing immediately northwest of the central access road. As it is the Division's understanding that Arvada wishes to reduce or release this site in the near future, care should be taken to maintain weed control efforts and attempt to reseed the remaining areas in need of further reclamation. Weed control efforts have been fairly diligent previously, but emphasis should be placed on removing any remaining noxious weeds as the site is prepared for final release.

No issues related to the hydrologic balance of the surrounding area were noted, and the mine entrance was adequately marked. No other issues were noted as part of this inspection.
